

Purpose of the Veranda Springs Social Committee

Keep all receipts for items purchased for the event as they must be turned in with the final report. (If you are purchasing items for yourself, please have them on a separate receipt for yourself). The other main duty is setting up and cleaning up the kitchen and hall immediately after or within 24 hours of the event. More detailed instructions will be given when you get the date and approval for the event. <u>All money</u>, receipts and forms are then returned to the social committee hopefully within 48 hours of the end of the event.

The committee is not responsible to host all of the events! We are here to help and assist any volunteering host with anything they need for the event. Feel free to talk to any one of us with event ideas or offers to host or help with an event. Help is always appreciated.






